- When required, make telephone calls/texts to service users to encourage attendance
- Welcome service users to the group
- Provide additional support to individual service users where identified by the supporting member of staff

It is important that the support provided remains within clear professional boundaries of befriending and is conducive to developing independence, a sense of self-worth and promoting community integration.
